

DESIGN BULLETIN #21/2003

Engineering Consultant Guidelines For Highway and Bridge Projects Volume 1, Design and Tender 2002 Revisions to Sections 3.4, 3.5 & Current References for Section 3 – November 2003

Summary: This design bulletin is being issued as an amendment to Alberta Transportation's Engineering Consultant Guidelines for Highway and Bridge Projects, Volume 1 Design and Tender 2002. *Section 3.4 Legal Surveys, Section 3.5 Reporting Requirements and Current References for Section 3* of the Guidelines have been amended as a result of recommendations and input from the Alberta Land Surveyors' Association. The recommendations/amendments were reviewed and approved in October 2003 by the Department.

Changes:

Key changes include the following:

- Except for expropriation surveys and subject to any special instructions issued by Alberta Transportation, the Consultant shall be responsible for the Legal Survey of the right-of-way.
- All service roads within a highway will be posted and labeled as "service roads".
- Where practical, efforts are to be made to consolidate existing road plans into the new survey.
- Upon completion of the project all appropriate affidavits and two (2) copies of the plan of survey shall be submitted to Alberta Transportation for review and execution.

Implementation

The included *Section 3.4 Legal Surveys, Section 3.5 Reporting Requirements and Current References for Section 3* (Dated November 2003) replaces Sections 3.4, 3.5 and Current References for Section 3 (Dated May 7, 2002) of the Engineering Consultant Guidelines for Highway and Bridge Projects, Volume 1 Design and Tender 2002.
