

52.4 REMOVING SNOW FENCE

52.4.1 GENERAL

The Work consists of removing existing snow fence.

52.4.2 MATERIALS

No materials are required for this Work.

52.4.3 EQUIPMENT

The Contractor shall supply all equipment necessary to complete the Work.

52.4.4 PROCEDURE

The Contractor shall obtain written permission from the landowner prior to entering private property.

The snow fence shall be removed from the site and the work area restored to its original condition. Restoration includes, but shall not be limited to the removal of staples and wire ties, which have fallen to the ground, and the filling of post holes.

The Contractor shall assume ownership of the removed snow fence material which is not designated for salvage.

When directed by the Engineer, snow fence materials shall be salvaged for re-use under this Contract and properly stored at the Contractor's storage location.

52.4.5 TIME TO COMPLETE

The Contractor shall complete the Work within 10 calendar days of the issuance of the Work Order.

52.4.6 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Measurement will be in metres of fence removed.

Payment will be made at the applicable unit price bid per metre for "Snow Fence - Removal" or "Snow Fence - Remove and Salvage." This payment will be full compensation for removing the snow fence from the site, proper storage of salvaged materials where applicable, restoring the work area to its original condition, and all labour, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the Work

52.4.7 WARRANTY

There is no warranty period for this Work.
