

## **53.18 SWEEPING - PICKUP BROOM**

### **53.18.1 GENERAL**

The Work consists of sweeping pavement surfaces with a pickup broom to remove, contain and dispose of sand, soil and other debris.

### **53.18.2 MATERIALS**

No materials are required for this Work.

### **53.18.3 EQUIPMENT**

The Contractor shall supply a pickup broom equipped with a gutter broom on each side.

### **53.18.4 PROCEDURE**

All Work shall be performed during daylight hours only, unless adequate lighting exists which provides visibility of at least 700 metres and prior approval of the Engineer is obtained. No Work shall be performed when the visibility is less than 700 metres.

Sweeping shall be performed in the same direction as the flow of the traffic.

Debris shall be removed from the pavement surface to within 10 mm of the curb and disposed of at a suitable location.

The sweeping operation shall be performed in a manner which prevents debris from being cast into the flow of traffic, into drainage inlets or onto sidewalks and curbs. Drainage inlets shall not be blocked.

### **53.18.5 TIME TO COMPLETE**

The Contractor shall complete the Work within 30 calendar days of the issuance of the Work Order.

### **53.18.6 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT**

Measurement will be in square metres of roadway surface swept, based on a minimum width of 1.8 m or the width of the broom being used, whichever is less.

Payment will be made at the unit price bid per square metre for "Sweeping - Pickup Broom". This payment will be full compensation removing debris from the roadway surface disposing of the debris and all labour, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the Work.

### **53.18.7 WARRANTY**

There is no warranty period for this Work.
