

55.7 DISPOSAL OF LARGE ROADKILL

55.7.1 GENERAL

The Work consists of the removal and disposal of animals from the right-of-way that have been killed or seriously injured in a collision. This Work will only apply to animals greater than 40 kg in weight.

55.7.2 MATERIALS

No materials are required for this Work.

55.7.3 EQUIPMENT

The Contractor shall supply all equipment necessary to complete the Work.

55.7.4 PROCEDURE

Traffic control and signing shall be performed in accordance with Specification 55.1, Traffic Accommodation and Temporary Signing.

The Contractor shall remove the entire carcass from the right-of-way and dispose of the carcass at approved sites. All carcasses shall be disposed of in an acceptable manner. The Contractor shall notify the local Fish and Wildlife Officer of roadkill incidents as specified in the Special Provisions.

If the animal is injured, the Contractor shall contact the RCMP or Fish and Wildlife, who will determine and arrange for the treatment required.

In cases involving domestic animals, the Contractor shall remove the carcass from the roadway surface and contact the owner of the animal to dispose of the carcass. If the owner cannot be contacted, the Contractor shall remove the carcass from the right-of-way, dispose of the carcass at an approved site and immediately notify the Engineer.

55.7.5 TIME TO COMPLETE

Carcasses shall be removed from the roadway surface immediately, and preferably disposed of at the same time. If circumstances dictate a delay, the disposal of the carcass shall be performed within the next 5 calendar days.

55.7.6 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The cost of this Work will be included in the unit price bid per month for "Highway Maintenance Work" in accordance with Specification 53.39, Highway Maintenance Work, and will not be paid for separately.

55.7.7 WARRANTY

There is no warranty period for this Work.
