Amendment to Specification 1.2, General, Re: Mobilization

The second paragraph of Section 1.2.13, MOBILIZATION AND DEMOBILIZATION, is replaced with the following:

The Department will pay for mobilization at the lump sum price bid for "Mobilization" which payment shall be compensation in full for all costs associated with mobilization. No payment for mobilization will be made until the value of the work completed on bid items other than mobilization exceeds 10% of the total tender price. Payments for interim crushing and stockpiling aggregate will be considered as value of Work completed on a bid item when payment for Mobilization is being considered.

When the amount bid for Mobilization exceeds 10% of the total original Contract tender amount, the Department will make an initial payment equal to 10% of the total original Contract tender amount. The amount bid for mobilization in excess of 10% and up to 20% of the total original Contract tender amount, will be paid in equal payments prorated over the remaining number of months until the specified Contract Completion Date. Any amount remaining when the bid for Mobilization exceeds 20% of the total original Contract tender amount will be withheld by the Department until the actual date of Construction Completion. When the actual completion of construction occurs prior to the specified Contract Completion Date, payment of any remaining amounts will be made at that time.

Notes to the Designer (Not to be included in tender)

The project must meet all of the following criteria in order to be considered for use:

- Proximity to major centres: Project must be located outside of 400 km radius from Grande Prairie,
 Edmonton, Calgary and Medicine Hat.
- Project consists of Multi-Phase construction, i.e. Grading, Base/Paving or Base/Paving. All with or without a major bridge component.
- Minimum tender value greater than \$20M.
