Southland Drive Interchange Improvements

Scope of Project

- Add thru lane (three core lanes)
- Remove lane drop just south of Anderson Road on-ramp
- Improve weaving length between Anderson Road and Southland Drive by moving the loop ramp at Southland Drive Interchange.
- Remove signal at Southland Drive Interchange on major NB to WB movement
- Add second exit lane for Deerfoot Meadows Shopping / Heritage Drive / WB Glenmore Exit
- Determine Extent of Land Exchange
- Environmental Assessment
- Historical Resources Review

Southland Drive Interchange Improvements

Goals / Objectives

- Socio Economic Benefits
 - Reduce daily delays for 60,000 commuters
 - Reduce idling time and greenhouse gas emissions
- Improve Road Safety
- Minimize impact to Sue Higgins Park

- Land Exchange with City of Calgary Roads Department
- Utility Coordination
