

Heart River Valley Slides (57+000 to 57+250)



Photo 1.
Slide No.4 is the first of several slides along the crest of the slope into the Heart River valley. The slide backscarp is 12 m wide, and roughly 5 m from the edge of pavement.



Photo 2.
Slide # 3 is the nearest slide to the end of the layby, at the north end of this section. The slide bowl is 35 m wide and the backscarp is within 6 m of the edge of pavement.



Photo 3

Slide No.2 is the closest slide to the road – only 4 m to edge of pavement, though as there is a layby at this point, it is 9 m to the edge of the active lane.



Photo 4.

Slide No.1 is the largest of the slides, roughly 35 m wide with its backscarp within 6 m of the edge of pavement.
