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Photo 1 – June 2009

Looking northeast along the edge of the road. Erosion gully has encroached onto the shoulder and is within 1 m of the tire tracks on the road surface. Stakes mark the June 2009 upslope extent of the gully for future comparison.



Photo 2 – June 2009 Looking southwest along the edge of the road (prior to the installation of the reference stakes visible in Photo 1. Surface runoff from the road is channelled into the head of the gully.

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Photo 3 – June 2009 Another view of the erosion gully encroaching onto the road surface.



Photo 4 – June 2009 The erosion gully from near the creek level.
