Alberta Transportation's Vehicle Safety Section has identified a need to enhance the delivery of information and technical support to Inspection Facilities and Technicians. To address this need an Educational & Technical Support Team (ETST) has been formed within the Vehicle Safety Section; the primary role of the ETST is to provide accurate and consistent information to all persons involved in Alberta's Vehicle Inspection Program including:

- Inspection Facility licensees
- Inspection Technicians
- Service Advisors
- Front office staff

We will be traveling throughout Alberta making presentations outlining administrative responsibilities for Inspection Facility licensees, Inspection Technicians, and any other personnel involved in the vehicle inspection process.
