New Equipment Requirements for School Buses

Effective September 1, 2010, all school buses must have, except where a municipal by-law prohibits their use, four amber and four red alternating flashing warning lamps, and a white flashing strobe light. In addition all school buses will have to be equipped with reflective markings (reflective tape).
