EXEMPTION BY REGISTRAR

The Director of the Vehicle Safety Section, Vehicle Safety and Carrier Services Branch, Transportation Safety Services Division, Alberta Transportation, pursuant to section 62(1)(iii) of the *Traffic Safety Act*, and section 114(1) of the *Vehicle Equipment Regulation* (122/2009), subject to the conditions and restrictions noted below, hereby exempts school buses, as defined under section 1(1)(k) of the *Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation* (121/2009), from the requirement under section 90(4) of the *Vehicle Equipment Regulation* (122/2009) to have a white flashing strobe lamp that complies with the requirements of CSA Standard D250-07.

Conditions:

School buses, as defined under section 1(1)(k) of the *Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation* (121/2009), must comply with the following conditions:

1. All school buses are covered under this exemption.
2. A school bus must have a white flashing strobe lamp that complies with the requirements of CSA Standard D250-07 or may be equipped with a class 2 strobe lamp, in accordance with SAE J1318.
3. The school bus driver, within 24 hours of the occurrence, must notify the Director of Vehicle Safety of any collision involving a motor vehicle while the school bus is operating with a strobe lamp, if the collision results in the death or disabling injury of a human being.
4. This exemption/ permit expires on December 1, 2015.
