



New Motorcycle Test

On January 19, 2009, a new motorcycle road testing model came into effect in Alberta.

People applying for a Class 6 motorcycle licence will be required to pass a road test in a traffic environment.

The length of the road test is 45 minutes. This will allow the driver examiner to fully assess the client's skills and abilities in a variety of road and traffic situations.

Motorcycle road tests are available at Alberta Registry offices. Road tests may also be available at approved motorcycle training schools for registered students.
