The current earth works at Stoney Trail and Crowchild Trail are expected to be completed in early August. Fencing and seeding are being completed as the last elements of this contract.

The detour of Crowchild Trail will remain in place as the plans for the City of Calgary's extension of the LRT to Rocky Ridge Road are developed and finalized.

A new contract for the construction of Scenic Acres Link/Tuscany Boulevard interchange at Stoney Trail has been awarded. The contractor, Graham Construction Ltd., will begin by doing preparatory work around Scenic Acres Link for the period of mid-July and August. Scenic Acres Link from Stoney Trail to Scurfield Drive will be closed for eight weeks in September and October to allow completion of construction work lowering Scenic Acres Link. A detour route will be signed to direct traffic to alternate routes in Scenic Acres during the road closure. The pedestrian crossing of Stoney Trail at Scenic Acres Link will be closed during the interchange construction project. The detour of Stoney Trail traffic around the bridge site will be in effect for up to 10 months (October 2008 to August 2009) during the construction of the bridges for the interchange project.
