#### **Completed Activities**

Bridge construction is complete. Stoney Trail is open to traffic with on and off ramps to the north. Aecom has been retained to plan, design and administer interchange construction upgrades.

Planning, preliminary engineering, detailed designs and tender documents have been submitted by the consultant and reviewed by Alberta Transportation.

The contract has been awarded to Volker Stevin Ltd. Earthworks of the ramps to and from eastbound Stoney Trail on the south side of the interchange are completed.

#### **Project Status for Summer 2010**

Volker Stevin mobilized to site in late July and are scheduling the earthworks, street lighting and paving of the ramps. The project is slightly behind schedule due to the inclement weather that has occurred in August and September.

#### **Next Steps**

Temporary closure of the westbound to northbound exit ramp from Stoney Trail to Shaganappi Trail is scheduled for September 23<sup>rd</sup>. This temporary closure is scheduled for approximately three weeks to allow for the modifications necessary for the construction of the remaining interchange. Concurrent with the closure of the ramp, paving will occur on the ramps to and from eastbound Stoney Trail. Overhead signs and street light modifications will continue. Volker Stevin will also be installing the traffic signals on Shaganappi Trail in September-October.

#### **Construction Information**

The original construction of the partial interchange included the future ramps and bridge fills for the expansion of the Shaganappi Trail Interchange. This allows the interchange to be expanded much quicker in 2010 and in the future when traffic warrants and funding is available.

## Stoney Trail and Shaganappi Trail will be a busy construction zone in 2010. Please do not enter as construction activity areas present significant hazards to the public.
