SUMMARY OF PUBLIC INPUT PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE June 18, 2009

CALGARY GLENMORE TRAIL/DEERFOOT TRAIL INTERCHANGE Stage 1 Design and Construction

An open house was held from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, June 18, 2009 at the Glenmore Inn to provide information regarding Stage 1 plans for the Glenmore Trail / Deerfoot Trial Interchange design.

The open house was well advertised through newspaper advertisements, flyer delivery and letters. The newspaper advertisements appeared in the Saturday, June 13 and Tuesday, June 16 editions of the Calgary Sun and the Calgary Herald. Seventeen flyer notifications were emailed to individuals who had requested to be kept on the contact list for the project from the initial flyer mail out. Bold signs along the sides of the road were placed for a week starting June 11 advertising the open house.

Approximately 180 people attended the open house with 14 comment sheets received the night of the open house. The following is a summary of the comments received grouped into categories. The numbers on the right indicate the number of similar comments received. All comments will be reviewed by the Design Team with Alberta Transportation as the project progresses.
