

Stoney Trail / Beddington Trail – Upcoming Detour

Calgary, July 10, 2006 – In order to realign and reconstruct Beddington Trail across the Transportation and Utility Corridor, including the future intersection with Stoney Trail, Beddington Trail will be detoured between July 15 and Aug. 6, 2006 (weather permitting).

The detour will be a gravel-surfaced two lane (one lane in each direction) roadway from approximately Hidden Creek Drive to Kincora Boulevard including the intersection with Panorama Road. Maintenance and dust abatement measures will be undertaken as required.

To reduce impacts to the travelling public and the environment, the detour's posted speed will be 30 km/h. This reduced speed will reduce the incidents of cracked windshields, paint chips, dust and noise pollution. Please obey all signs and speed limits while driving through the area.
