Completed Activities

Aecom has been retained to plan, design and administrate the interchange construction. Acciona Infrastructure Canada has been awarded the construction contract for the project.

Acciona has completed the Nose Hill Drive bridge pile foundations, the centre piers, the abutments and the lifting of the bridge girders. The southbound Stoney Trail bridge and the adjacent pedestrian bridge are complete.

The pedestrian pathway between the communities of Scenic Acres and Tuscany is open to the public.

Construction of the retaining walls at the north end of the wildlife underpass is complete.

Project Status for Fall 2013

Acciona is progressing with concrete deck construction of the Nose Hill Drive bridge over Stoney Trail.

Earth works will continue with the construction of Nose Hill Drive on both sides of Stoney Trail and on the new southbound Stoney Trail between Scenic Acres Link/Tuscany Boulevard and Nose Hill Drive. Gravel and asphalt paving in these areas is progressing.

Reconstruction of the retaining wall at the south end of the wildlife underpass, underground storm system, street lighting and overhead guide signs are all being advanced.

Next Steps

Construction of the new southbound Stoney Trail roadway between Nose Hill Drive and the Bow River bridge.

Bridge widening construction is anticipated to commence on the existing CPR bridge once the southbound Stoney Trail bridge is open to traffic.

Construction of the permanent pathway in the southwest quadrant connecting the new pedestrian bridge over CPR to the regional pathway system.

Various traffic detours are anticipated during the fall and winter 2013/14. Additional information on detours are provided under the 'Maps' section of the project web page. The schedule for construction and opening of detours and permanent roadways is subject to inclement weather.
