# **Project Update**

### **Completed Activities**

The Eastside ramps for the future interchange were cut to grade as part of borrowing material for the Trans-Canada/Stoney Interchange. The project is to be tendered this spring with work beginning in early summer.

## **Project Status for Spring 2008**

The project will be tendered this spring and construction will be initiated in early summer 2008. A March 2008 open house displayed the construction staging and the final layout design for Scenic Acres Link and Tuscany Boulevard. The display also showed the construction schedule for the new lowered Scenic Acres and the Stoney Trail detour over the summer with traffic being routed to the detour early this fall.

#### **Next Steps**

- Scenic Acres Link will be closed for the months of July and August to allow construction of the detour and new intersection.
- Stoney Trail traffic will be detoured to the new interchange ramps to allow construction of the Stoney Trail bridges to overpass the new Scenic Acres Link.
- The bridges will require the full winter, spring and early summer to complete.
- Stoney Trail will be reconstructed and opened to traffic following bridge completion.
- Tuscany Boulevard intersection with StoneyTrail will be closed with the openning of the reconstructed Stoney Trail. Tuscany Bvd traffic will be rerouted to the new interchange at the same time.
- Reopening of Stoney Trail will remove two signals from the through traffic streams.

#### **Construction Information**

Information on subsequent phases will be provided in future updates.

Speed reductions will be in place and off-peak lane closures will be required periodically. On occasion, nighttime work and associated detours and lane closures will be necessary. Signs will be placed to notify motorists in advance. Drivers should be aware the fines for speeding in a construction zone are doubled when workers are present.
