Transit comes in all sizes:

- The smallest GreenTRIP contribution to date supported Banff and Canmore with much needed local service that also increases tourism opportunities.
- The largest GreenTRIP contributions approved to date support Edmonton's new Metro LRT line and Calgary's West LRT line, which will transform the way residents get around their cities.



Calgary's West LRT line opened December 2012 and is anticipated to carry 40,000 passengers a day within the next few years.
