
Alberta Infrastructure and Transportation - Summary of Grants / Programs Provided to Municipalities

The tables on the following pages provide a high level summary of eligible municipalities, and eligible project types and components under the various municipal grant programs administered by Alberta Infrastructure and Transportation.

These tables are for quick reference only and do not replace or modify the details outlined in the Program Agreements, Administrative Procedures, or other Guidelines applicable to each program.

In programs where the municipal infrastructure is classified as either "Core" or "Other" the municipality must certify that the "Core" infrastructure is in good condition before projects in the "Other" category may become eligible.

In some programs, the eligibility of a particular project may be limited by provincial priorities and budget constraints,
