PRODUCT

S32 erosion control blankets are manufactured by ErosionControlBlanket.com and distributed by Cascade Geotechnical Inc. of Edmonton.

VENDOR CLAIMS AND INFORMATION

CLAIMS:

The erosion control blankets are used for erosion control for side slopes, for low and sheet water flow rates.

DESCRIPTION:

S32 from ErosionControlBlanket.com is a 100% agricultural straw blanket stitched with 2 photo/degradable polypropylene nets (1.49 x 1.27 cm mesh size). The "S" represents straw, the "3" represents that the blanket has an average of 300 gm/m², the "2" represents that the blanket is netted on 2 sides. The functional longevity of the blanket is approximately 1 year depending on moisture, light and winter conditions. The blanket is sewn together with biodegradable multifilament thread.

POTENTIAL USAGE:

The erosion control blankets are used for erosion control for side slopes, for low and sheet water flow rates.

STANDARDS:

Cascade Geotechnical Inc has provided a Material Safety Data Sheet for Green-1 (biodegradable thread).
