VENDOR CLAIMS AND INFORMATION

CLAIMS

The Energite III System Crash Cushion has been tested to the guidelines as specified in NCHRP 350 TL-3, for non-re-directive crash cushions. The Energite III System features many advantages: including a one piece barrel design and a snap-on lid.

DESCRIPTION

The Energite III System Crash Cushion is a non-directive, easy to install crash cushion consisting of a number of sand-filled, polyethylene plastic modules that are installed in a specific geometric array in front of a hazard. The cone insert is used to adjust the sand height or center of mass and the overall weight of the barrel. The barrels weight requirement is determined by its place within the array.

POTENTIAL USAGE

Energite III System Crash Cushions are installed in a specific geometric array in front of a hazard. The Energite III System Crash Cushion modules are available in a wide range of sizes (90 kg to 960 kg). The Energite III System Crash Cushion one piece barrel requires no assembly which simplifies and speeds up installation, the barrels are also stackable for easy transport and storage.
