CLAIMS

GUIDE LITE is designed to allow for snow plows and other road maintenance equipment to glide over the product, without cast iron debris. The GUIDE LITE weighs substantially less than similarly sized cast iron markers.

DESCRIPTION

The GUIDE LITE is a lightweight, snow plowable, raised pavement marker. It is made of a durable plastic material with abrasion resistant steel rub rails. Installation involves using standard industry reflectors, slot cutting equipment, and adhesive. It weighs 1.25 lbs. and reflector height is 0.25 inch above the pavement surface.

POTENTIAL USAGE

It can be installed on Concrete or Asphalt surface with standard slot cutting equipment.
