The HD-21A Durable Waterborne paint system appears to look good in some of the areas of highway 43. However, there are some bad areas where the paint has worn badly. The retroreflection readings are very low, therefore night time reflectance would be a problem.

Repainting of these lines will be required during this coming spring as the durability and retroreflection on most of this stretch of roadway is not acceptable.
