DESCRIPTION

Tiger Salt Deicing Material is a by-product of calcium chloride and its active ingredients are 96.5% sodium Chloride, 0.85% calcium chloride, 0.1% magnesium chloride, 2.5% moisture and 0.05% iron.

POTENTIAL USAGE

Tiger Salt Deicing Material is spread evenly over snow or icy surfaces at a rate of ¼ to ½ cup per square yard (50 to 100g per m²). When Tiger Salt is used as directed it will not harm grass, shrubs, concrete or wild life. Tiger Salt melts down to -25°C.
