# OHV Helmet Requirements on Public Land Come Into Effect on May 15, 2017

## Helmets are not required:

- On private property
- On First Nations Reserve or Métis Settlement Lands
- For farm and ranch workers riding for work
- For on-highway vehicles used off-road and OHVs with rollover protective structures when seatbelts are being worn
- For members of Sikh religion wearing a turban
- When an exemption is granted by the Registrar
- For other workers where Alberta occupational health and safety laws do not require helmet use

## Fine for not complying:

- Not wearing a helmet - \$155
- Allowing a minor under 14 to not wear a helmet - \$155
- Wearing an approved helmet that is damaged or modified in some way or is missing the approved helmet label - \$93
